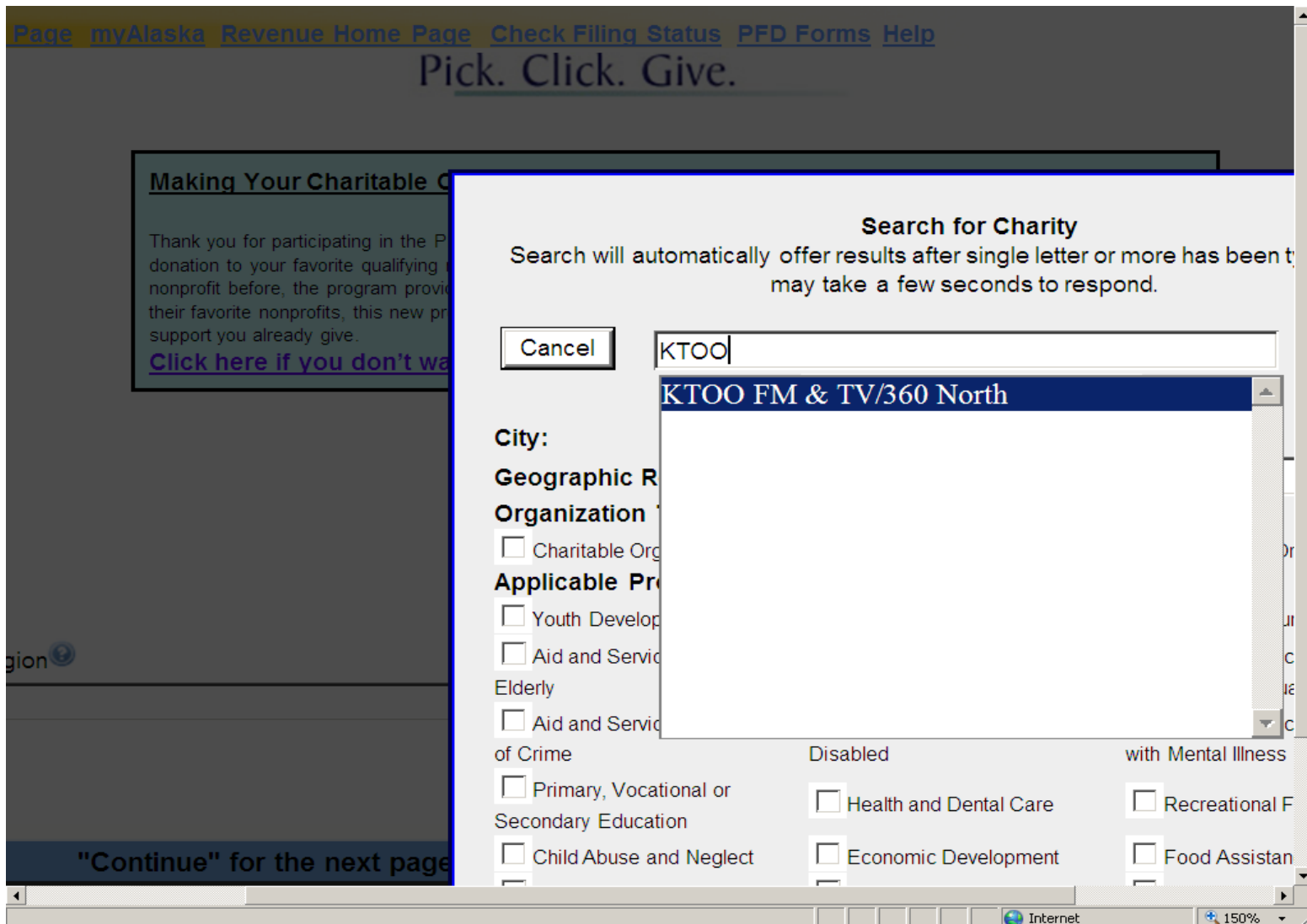

The state site is available during the PFD application period, from January 1 through March 31. If you want to get started early, though, www.PickClickGive.org is live year-round. You can find out today if your favorite organization is on the list, you can build your personal list ahead of time, you can check out stories of impact from organizations who received Pick.Click.Give. donations, or, if you are an organization, the site has tips and tools for reaching out to donors.
